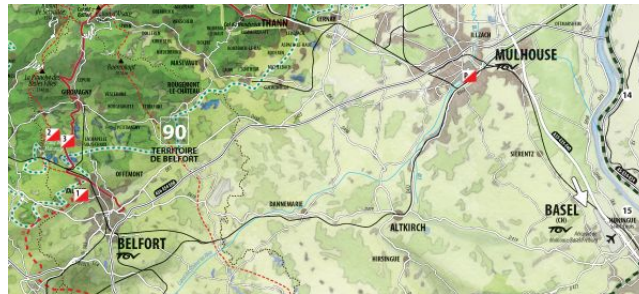

 - Day 1: Hilly terrain with steep slopes, dense path network, mix of good runnability and undergrowth vegetation (brambles), visibility varies but mainly good. Covered legs recommended.
 - Day 2: Hilly terrain with steep slopes and deep valleys, minor terrain features, several paths, good runnability and with good visibility.

 - Day 1: scale: 1/10.000 – contour interval: 5m
 - Day 2: scale: 1/15.000 – contour interval: 5m
